- **We may schedule your appointment two weeks out to protect the health and safety of our other patients and staff if:**
 - **You or anyone in your household have been to Level 2 and 3 destinations - China, Japan, South Korea, Italy, or Iran in the last 14 days, or knowingly been in close contact with anyone diagnosed with Coronavirus**
 - **You are experiencing flu-like or upper respiratory symptoms, fever, cough or shortness of breath.**

As far as our company policies, staff continue to wash their hands before and after every patient encounter, cleans exercise equipment after each patient, uses fresh linens for each patient and requests that if patients are febrile or have traveled from higher risk areas to please cancel your appointment to avoid the spread of infection.
